

Promises Divine

Characteristics of God's Promises:

Unfailing

1 Kings 8:56 Blessed be the Lord, that hath given rest unto His people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised by the hand of Moses His servant.

Assured by Divine Ability

Romans 4:21 And being fully persuaded, that what He has promised, He was able also to perform.

Grounded in Christ

2 Cor. 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are yea, and in Him Amen, unto the glory of God by us. (2 Co. 7:1)

Of Infinite Value

2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Culminate in Everlasting Life

I John 2:25 And this is the promise that He hath promised us, even eternal life.

Brighter Days

Psalm 30:5 For His anger endureth but a moment; in His favor is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

Deliverance

Psalm 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all.

Divine Care in Sickness

Psalm 41:3 The Lord will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make all his bed in his sickness. (Psalm 50:i 94:12; 138:7)

Comfort of God's Presence

Isaiah 43:2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

An Eternal Home

John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

All Things work for the Believer's Good

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for the good of them that love God, to them who re the called according to his purpose.

2 Cor. 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;

Sufficiency of Divine Grace

2 Cor. 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Fellowship in Christ's Sufferings

I Peter 4:12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

2 Peter 4:13 But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.

Membership in the Company of the Redeemed,

Rev. 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they?

Rev. 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Final Deliverance from Sorrow and Pain

Rev. 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away.

Bodily Supplies

Psalm 37:3 Trust in the Lord, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

Unlimited Blessings

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

Answers to Prayers

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Removal of Obstacles

Luke 17:6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamore tree, Be thou plucked up by the room, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

Divine Sonship

John 1:12 But as many as received him to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name.

Eternal Life

John 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up.

John 3:15 That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life (John 5:24)

Spiritual Fullness

John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. (John 11:26)

Spiritual Light

John 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

Power for Service

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Promises Divine Continued

Salvation

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek (1 Peter 2:6)

To the Humble

Psalm 138:6 Though the Lord be high, yet hath He respect unto the lowly: but the proud He knoweth afar off.

Isaiah 66:2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the Lord: but to this many will I look; even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word. (Luke 9:48)

James 4:6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

I Peter 5:5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

To the Liberal

Psalm 41:1 Blessed is he that considereth the poor: the Lord will deliver him in time of trouble.

Proverbs 3:9 Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase.

Proverbs 3:10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine. Proverbs 11:25 The liberal soul shall be riade fat: and he that watereth shall be watered also himself. (Prov. 22:9; 28:27; Eec 11:1)

Isaiah 58:10 And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again. (Luke 14:14)

2 Cor. 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

To the Obedient

Exodus 20:6 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Deut. 4:40 Thou shalt keep therefore His statues, and His commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days upon the earth, which the Lord thy God giveth thee, for ever.

I Kings 11:38 And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do that is right in my sight, to keep my statues and my commandments as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

Isaiah 1:19 If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land.

Mark 3:35 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.

Luke 11:28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it. John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

To the Penitent

Psalm 34:18 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Jeremiah 3:22 Return, ye backsliding c and I will heal your backslidings. Behold, we come unto thee; for thou art the Lord our God.

Joel 2:13 And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God: for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and rep enteth him of the evil. Micah 7:18 Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgressions of the remnant of His heritage? He retaineth not His anger for ever, because He delighteth in mercy. (Luke 6:2 1)

Luke 15:7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
